	5 West	40	General Surgery; Trauma; Vascular; Plastic Surgery; telemetry unit.
	6 West	28	Medicine; Neurology; Family Practice; Child Health (adult chronic illness); telemetry.
	7 West	18	General M/S patients; some short stay; burn/wound; overflow from other M/S units.
Adult Step-down	4 West	20	Step-Down Unit: multidisciplinary to include medical/cardiac, surgical, trauma, etc.
Adult Critical Care Units	SICU	18	Adult Trauma [85%]; major surgical cases from other specialties.
	CICU	18	Medical Cardiology; CV Surgery; Oncology.
	MNSICU	18	Medical ICU [pulmonary, GI bleed, overdose, etc]; Neurology; Neurosurgery; Trauma overflow.
	BICU	14	Burn and wound patients; provides comprehensive care [clinic and OR].
Pediatric Units	Pediatrics	28	Care of "floor status" patients up to 13 y/o with any diagnosis.
	Adolescent Unit	14	Care of "floor status" patients 13-18 with any diagnosis.
	Peds ICU	11	Critical care of patients up to 18 y/o with any diagnosis.
